Step 1: Log in to the shop backend, after downloading the AquaTheme from the store, navigate to Extensions > My extensions > Themes. Click on the install button at the theme listed there.

Step 1: After downloading the Theme Aqua, login to shop backend and follow these steps to install the Theme Aqua

1. Once logged in, navigate to the "Extensions" section.
2. From the dropdown menu, select "My extensions."
3. Look for the "Themes" tab and click on it.
4. Locate the Theme Aqua from the list of available themes.
5. Click on the "Install" button next to the AquaTheme.

Step 2: Then, click on the toggle switch to enable the Theme Aqua and activate it.

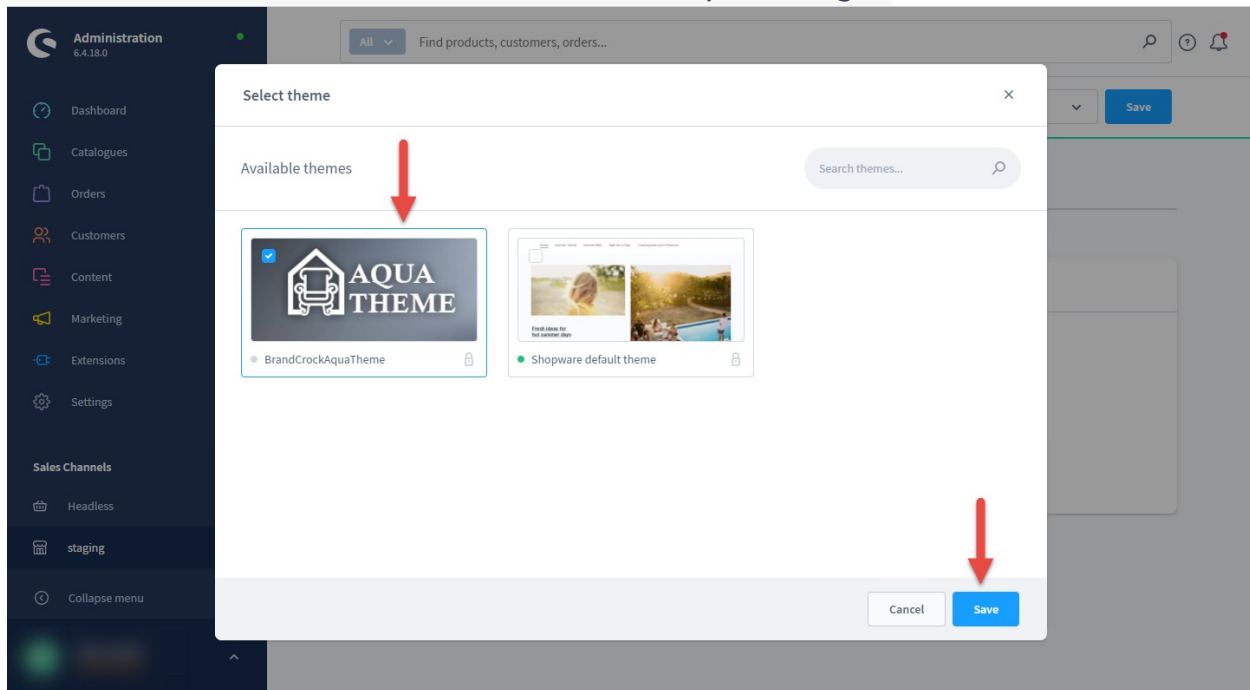



Theme Uninstallation

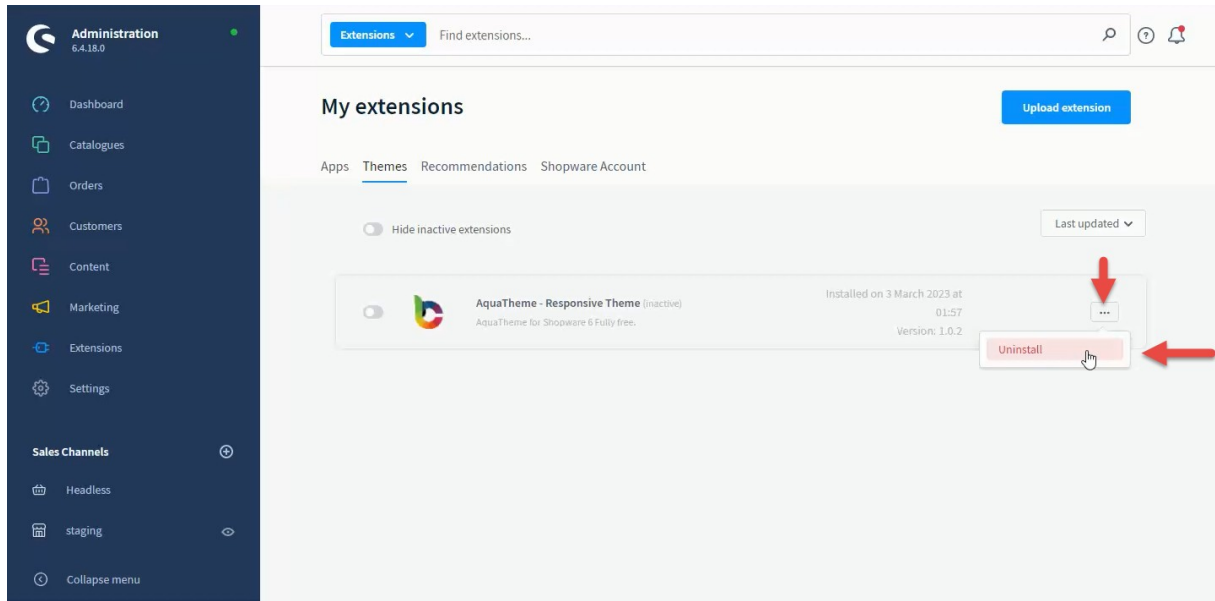
To uninstall the theme, you need to deactivate it first. It's a two-step process defined below
